Introduction	This reference tool identifies potential small and diverse-owned suppliers and vendors. Inclusion on this list does not imply endorsement or recommendation; it is a starting point for further evaluation.
Purpose	This list's primary purpose is to streamline the supplier identification process. It is designed to assist users in finding potential partners based on their specific needs.
Due Diligence	Users are reminded that inclusion on the supplier list does not substitute for thorough due diligence. Organizations must conduct their assessments, considering capacity, reputation, financial stability, and compatibility with specific requirements.
