A Quality CHIS Improves Community Health

CHIS sets the foundation for a clear, community-centered strategic plan to improve health for all across Ventura County

CHIS - Driving Action

Solidifies Priorities – establishes VCCHIC's goals and strategic objectives for next 3 years

Sets Path for Collective Action – initiates implementation workgroups, collaborative activities and assessment

Improves Impact – focuses on effective implementation, operations, and long-term accountability via goals, impact metrics, and assigned responsibilities

CHIS – Advancing Values

Equity & Inclusion – collaborative process prioritizing community expertise; continuous outreach & communication; focus on addressing health inequities

Prevention & Wellness – seeking upstream interventions to address inequitable drivers of poor health – emphasizing access and care navigation

Collaborative Partnership – joining efforts to exceed the sum of our parts; building & sustaining partnerships via joint decision-making, capacity-building, and implementation

CHIS – Process Goals

Local Knowledge – tap into broad regional expertise in priority areas, including operations and cross-cutting objectives of health access, navigation, and equity

Data Informed – draw on all CHNA inputs – including community member expertise from surveys, focus groups, etc. – in decision-making

Strategically Aligned – complements ongoing plans and actions where relevant, avoids overlap & duplication

CHIS – Process Goals

Flexible – maintains room to pivot to meet shifting landscape needs and capabilities over its 3-year cycle

Feasible – clear, streamlined objectives that calibrate collective capacity with community needs

Accountable – sets clear goal indicators that can be easily tracked to regularly evaluate & communicate progress

Collaborative – no one organization carries the load alone – but all are committed to ensuring the priorities are met
